



OUR MISSION

The Corporation Maison Lucien-L'Allier is a non-profit organization that offers long-term affordable housing with support services for individuals with mental health problems.

The support services offered encourages empowerment to remain autonomous and be an active member in the organization: involvement in various committees and/or maintenance of the building, and if necessary, the referral to community resources.

Lastly, we encourage residents to actively participate towards their quality of life within the community and to maintain their treatment plan.

HISTORY AND VOCATION OF THE CORPORATION MAISON LUCIEN-L'ALLIER

The Corporation Maison Lucien L'Allier was conceived through the determination of some of the tenants that resided on Overdale Street. They were seeking rights and dignity, to be recognized and to be provided with a roof over their heads in the neighborhood where they had always lived. MLL was sponsored by the Office Municipal de Montreal and opened its doors in April 1988. Since its creation the need was increasingly felt to give shelter to people living with mental health problems so that now we only accept this clientele. We continue to encourage our tenants to live autonomously,

with a sense of responsibility and the ability to live in society. The house receives men and women 18 and older.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the **Corporation Maison Lucien-L'Allier** are as follows:

- ✓ To provide community housing with support services in mental health
- ✓ To provide affordable long-term housing for the community who have a mental health diagnosis that are stable and autonomous individuals
- ✓ To provide activities that enhance social integration within community based living; improving of the quality of life of tenants
- ✓ To educate and empower tenants of mental health rights through workshops
- ✓ The mutual respect of all tenants and staff members are encouraged and promoted at MLL

ACTIVITIES AT MLL

Leisure and physical activities and outings are held in order to respect the diversity and rhythms tenants. We offer different types of activities that vary. These activities allow our tenants to break their isolation, to bond, to regain confidence in themselves and foster their sense of belonging within the MLL community.

ACTIVITIES AT MLL

At the **Corporation Maison Lucien L'Allier**, although participation in activities is encouraged, it still remains an option to tenants. The most popular activities returning from month to month such as collective and community kitchens, bingo and billiards outings. Activities take place from Monday to Friday, mostly in the afternoon.

CONDITIONS FOR ELIGIBILITY

- a) Have completed the housing application form of the Corporation Maison Lucien L'Allier;
- b) Be a man or a single woman (e) 18 years and over;
- c) To have diagnosed mental health problems;
- d) Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- e) Have gross income for the previous year, equal to or less than \$ 27,500;
- f) To have a help, a support or monitoring of a mental health professional (psychiatrist, physician, nurse, social worker, etc.) or a mental health worker (intervenant) from an organization recognized in mental health
- g) To have property whose value does not exceed \$ 50,000;
- h) Not have any serious criminal records;
- i) To consent to respect the code of conduct and regulations of the Corporation Maison Lucien-L'Allier.

Important: We offer a support service for mental health and not of supervised housing.

SPECIFIC INFORMATION ON HOUSING UNITS

The **Corporation Maison Lucien-L'Allier** Has: 27 housing units, including 21 rooms (2 studios and 4 apartments subsidized by the OMHM).

In this area there is a kitchenette with stove, refrigerator, cabinets and sink unit. In addition, a cupboard also included in this space.

Lastly, the bathroom and the toilet are to be shared by 4 or 5 tenants depending on the section that the rooms are located in the house.
